

BMFA PUSSYCAT

The rules will include three duration and three precision flights however you may build and use two Pussycat models (one with trike undercarriage and the other with tail dragger two wheel version). A single motor must be used in each version for all competition flights. It is not essential to build two models if you prefer to use a single model for all your competition flights however a tip from the Norwind indoor group is the trike undercarriage version is better for precision flights while the two wheel version comes out top for duration flights. The times of the precision flights will be provided on the day of the competition.

If you wish to be in front of the game Brian Lever has plans and full building instructions for the Pussycat (which is a great indoor flyer in either configuration). If you send your full address details to Brian at blever@btinternet.com he will send you a plan free of charge and you can commence building to be ready for the first Bushfield Indoor competition on the 17th October 2026. As usual there will be cash prizes for the overall winners and laminated certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places at each individual meeting.
