

**NEW AND EXCITING GYMINNIE CRICKET COMPETITION  
BEING HELD AT BUSHFIELD SPORTS CENTRE  
PETERBOROUGH PE2 5RQ  
RUN OVER 6 INDOOR MEETINGS for dates SEE PMFC WEBSITE**

**RULES:**

- 1) **GYMINNIE CRICKET MUST BE BUILT FROM THE BMFA KIT (Supplied free by Brian Lever ( [blever@btinternet.com](mailto:blever@btinternet.com)) including use of kit supplied tissue, wood and prop.**
- 2) **Competition flights to take place at Bushfield Sports Centre (see times and dates on the PMFC website.**
- 3) **Model to be flown for Duration and Precision. Note apart from replacing rubber motors just one model may be used for the entire competition.**
- 4) **At each competition you are allowed 3 hand launched duration and precision flights and watch stops when flight ceases including hang-ups.**
- 5) **Precision flights will be to three predetermined times of 47 seconds, 23 seconds and 39 seconds. These same times will be used at each meeting.**
- 6) **Winners per meeting will be determined by the total of their three duration flights in seconds LESS the total error in seconds of their three precision flights.**
- 7) **To keep the interest high until the final meeting in March 2026 the competitors with the six best scores at close of play on that day will be the overall winners.**
- 8) **All competition flights must be nominated by the flyer and timed by a BMFA member.**
- 9) **Entrants may spend time prior to official flights selecting the best motor and making trimming and test flights. Once the competitor has made the first competition flight NO FURTHER TRIMMING IS ALLOWED.**
- 10) **When the best rubber motor is selected this becomes the one to be used on the three duration and three precision flights. In the event of a motor breaking and no longer being able to be repaired during the competition it may be replaced BUT no further trimming flights with the new motor are allowed once the competitor has already made competition flights.**
- 11) **When the competitor has completed the three duration flights no further trimming is allowed prior to commencing the three precision flights. Competitors must use the knowledge gained from their duration flights to help calculate the number of winds required for their precision flights.**
- 12) **£100 of prize money will be awarded to the three highest scores obtained at any of the meetings from 29<sup>th</sup> November onwards in the ratio of £50, £30, £20 by close of play at the final competition.**
- 13) **Laminated certificates will be awarded to the top three competitors at every meeting and to the six best times achieved by March 2026.**
